Self-Arranged Altar Flowers - Summer Guidelines

Parishioners are welcome to provide their own altar flower arrangements during the summer months, from **June 22 until August 24, 2025**. If you'd like to participate, please follow these simple guidelines:



1. Sign Up

- Add your name to the sign-up sheet in the hallway or contact the church office
 with your preferred Summer Sunday at least two weeks in advance to check
 availability.
- Your dedication will be included in the service bulletin if submitted **by the prior Sunday**.

2. Arranging

- You may **create your own arrangement** or order from a florist—all styles and skill levels are welcome.
- Each Sunday's flowers should consist of **two coordinated arrangements**, each measuring no larger than roughly **30 inches tall and wide by 8 inches deep**.
- Arrangements should be appropriately sized for the space—not too large or too small.

3. Drop-Off & Setup

- Use a **stable**, **leak-proof vase or container**, ready to be placed directly on the altar.
- Vases and containers are available to borrow from the flower room—look for the designated area the Sunday before your turn.
- Please bring your arrangements on Sunday morning. Flowers should be **set up on the altar by 9:30 AM**.

4. Cleanup & Removal

- After the service, you may **take your flowers with you** or leave them to remain for the week.
- If left behind, the church office will handle removal when needed.
